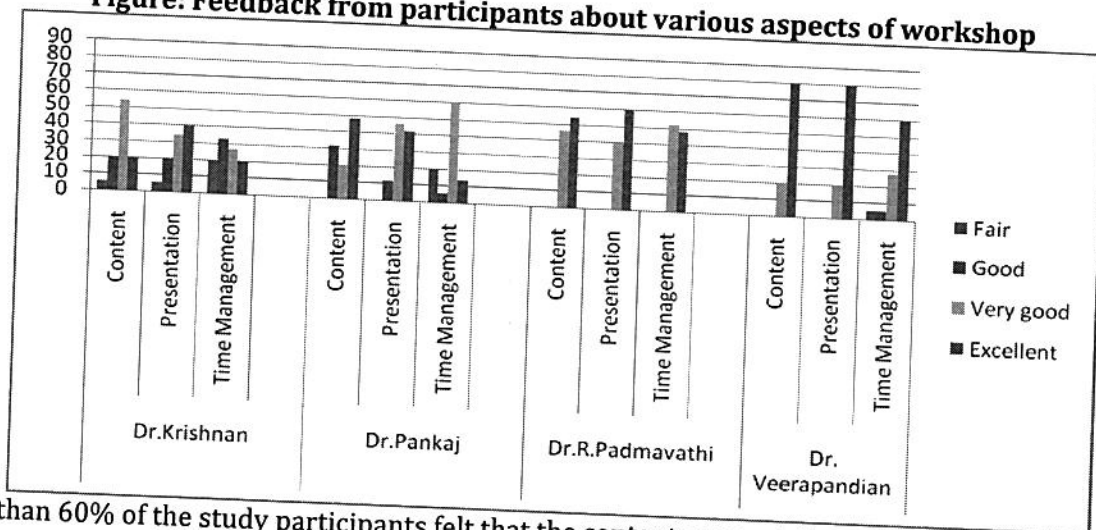
Registration:

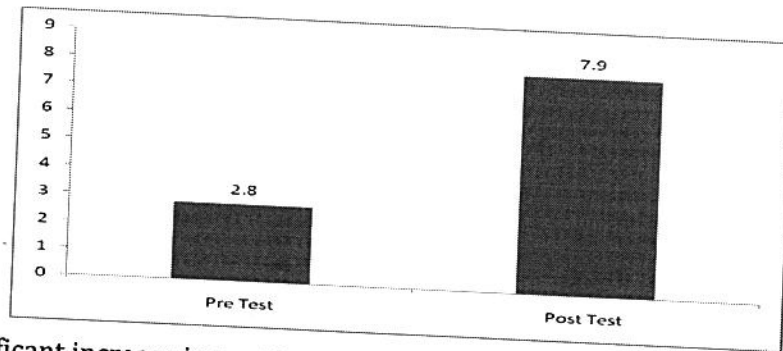
Figure: Comparison of pre and post test scores of the study participants

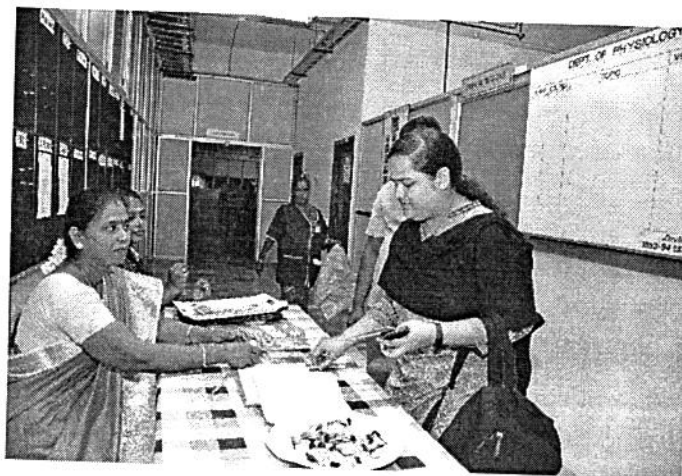
The objectives of the workshop are given below:

SESSION 1: REFERENCE-MANAGEMENT

Speaker explained about the differences between various terminologies such as

- a. Reference list - contain only the details of the sources cited in the body of the text.
- b. Bibliography - may also include all details of other sources being consulted when researching a piece of work but may not have been cited in the text.
- c. Citation - a specific source that is mentioned in the body of the paper.

Different reference styles like Chicago, MLA (Modern Language Association), ACS (American Chemical Society), IEEE (Institute Of Electrical And Electronics Engineers), NLM (National Library Of Medicine), Vancouver (Biological Sciences), AAA (American Anthropological Association), APA (American Psychological Association), APSA (American Political Science Association) etc were introduced in this session.

Different reference softwares like Endnote, Mendeley, Revman, Zotero, Reference Manager etc were also introduced.

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SESSION 2: ANATOMY OF MENDELEY SOFTWARE

The speaker explained about various features of mendeley software. The important ones are listed below.

- MendeleyDesktop -A software that helps us organize our references (offline)
- MendeleyWeb -A research catalogue of 350million documents, 100000 collaborators and 2 million research groups
- Web Importer -Importer of references from various sources (online)
- MS Word Plug in –Citing references in MS word document (offline)

SESSION 3: CREATING A MENDELEY LIBRARY

Creating Mendeley library using various methods were explained with hands on training.

Option 1: Importing from online databases –Pubmed, Google Scholar

Option 2: Importing article pdfs

Option 3: Manual entry –journals, books, webpages

SESSION 4: MANAGING YOUR MENDELEY LIBRARY

Following tasks were explained with hands on training.

1. Checking for duplicates
2. Using filters
3. Using tags
4. Mark Read / Unread
5. Mark favourites

SESSION 5: CITATION USING PLUG IN

Citing references and creating a bibliography in MS Word using the MS Word Plug in was explained. A task of placing the references exactly in the same places and style using the Mendeley Desktop and MS Word Plug in based on the model word document was given to all the participants.

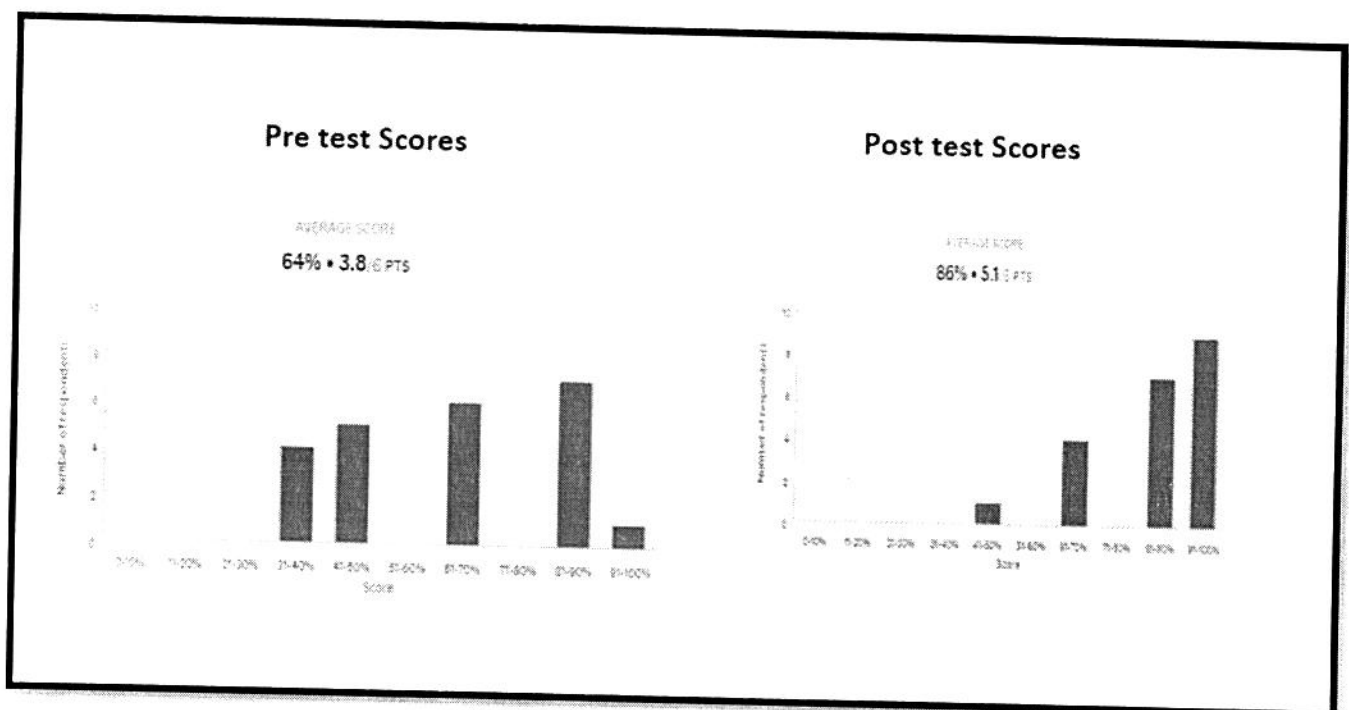

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SESSION 6: CREATING-GROUPS-IN-MENDELEY

The participants were trained in creating different types of groups namely Public, Invite only and Private. Process of creating folders and sub folders was also demonstrated during this session.

PRETEST AND POST TEST ANALYSIS:

Online pretest, posttest and feedback through survey monkey was collected from the delegates. The program evaluation showed that average score for pre-test analysis was 64% and Post-test analysis was 86%.
