On this Special Day,

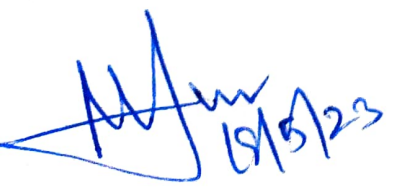

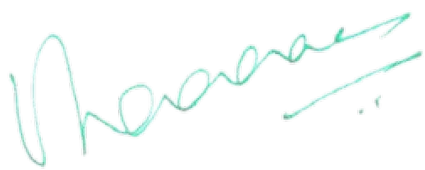

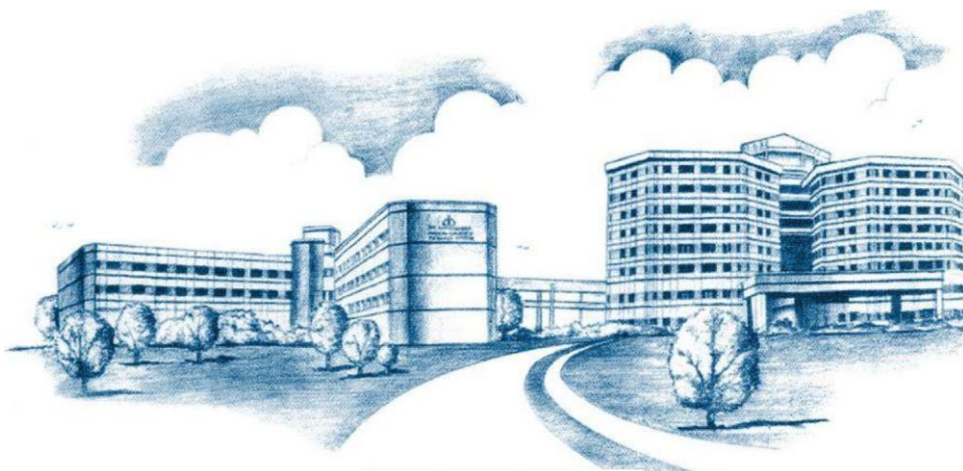

Workshop on - “*Instrumentation in Musculoskeletal Research*”

Sri Ramachandra faculty of physiotherapy organized a workshop titled “Instrumentation in Musculoskeletal Research” on 25.06.2022. The faculties of musculoskeletal unit were the resource faculties for the program. The objective of workshop was to highlight the evidence based clinical utility of various devices and tools used in musculoskeletal research and provide hands on experience with Inclinator, Hand held dynamometer, Pressure algometry, Pressure biofeedback, and Neck proprioception maze. The target participants were PhD scholars, Postgraduates, Interns and final semester students.

The workshop was held on 25th June, 2022 from 8.30 am until 4 pm; around 104 participants from various institutes of Chennai including SRIHER, Andhra Pradesh had attended the program. Prof. P Antony Leo Aseer, Vice Principal, welcomed the participants and briefed about the workshop and learning objectives.

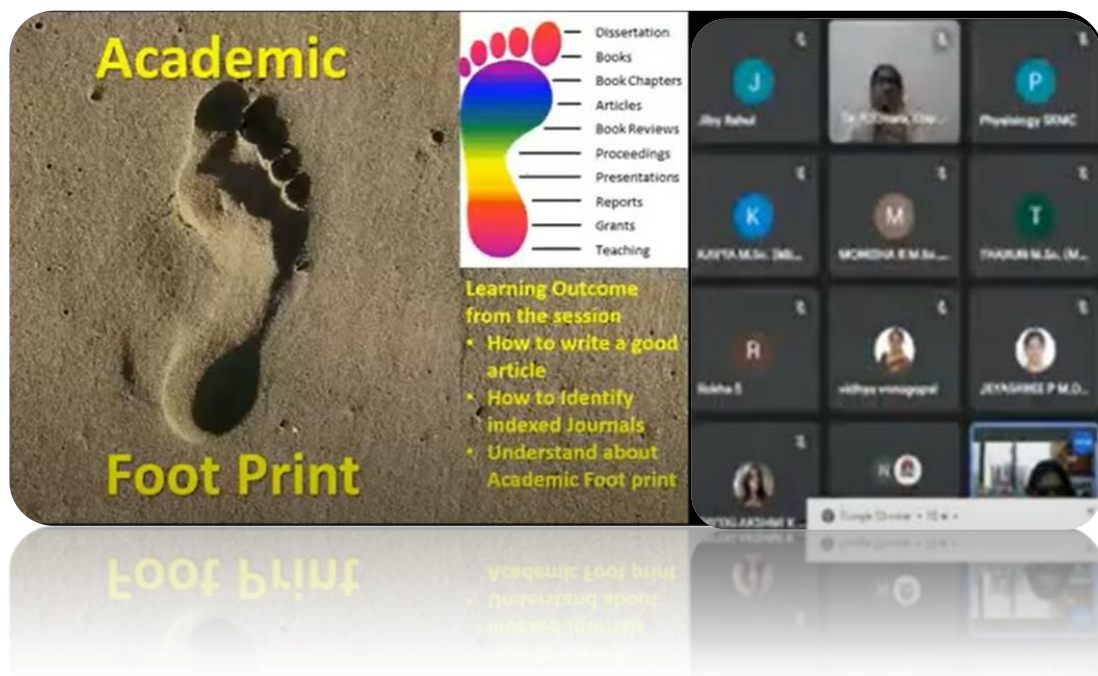

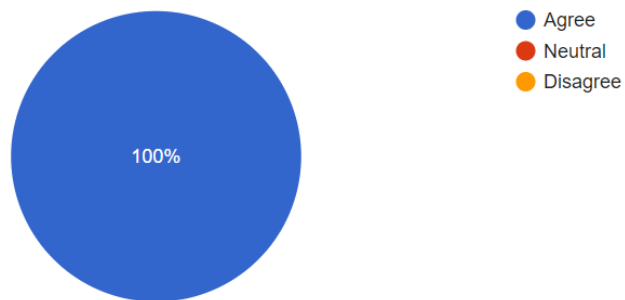
Dr.Abirami Omprakash , Associate Professor of Physiology proposed the vote of thanks.

Feedback was collected from the delegates and analyzed. The participants unanimously agreed that it was an informative program and wished to attend many such programs in future.

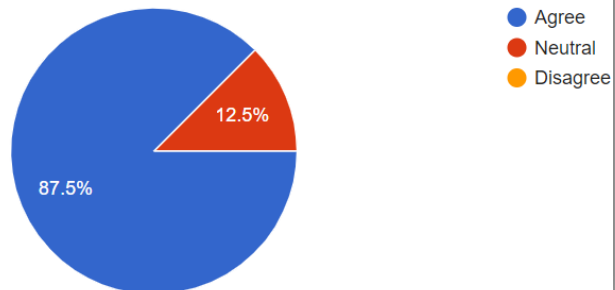

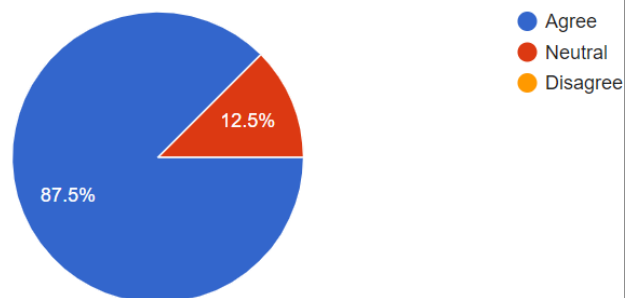

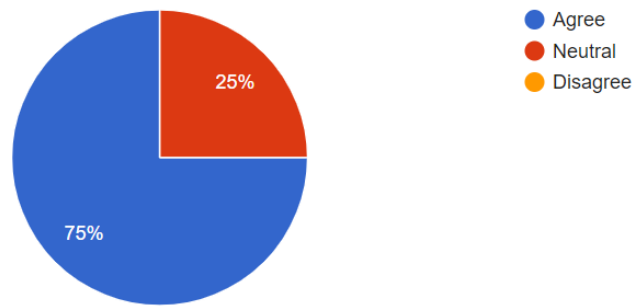

Remarks	A seminar was conducted at SRFMS on 14 Jul 2022 where in the participants from Hull University were addressed in addition to students pursuing MBA and BBA courses at SRFMS.
Objective (100 of 100 left)	The seminar covered "DIGITAL HEALTH INITIATIVES IN INDIA" and the speakers were Dr. Amish R Parekh, CEO and co-founder of NEOs HEALTHTECH and Dr. Sujini Ponnusamy, co-founder, CSO- product development optimal oncology.
Benefit in terms of learning /skill/knowledge obtained* (150 of 150 left)	The first speaker Dr. Amish R Parekh spoke on the shortage of radiologists and the difficulties that are likely to impinge our Healthcare more over in an Open Digital ECI system (ODE) Era. He further dwelt on AI, Big chain & Block Data. In line with National Digital Health Mission, post office will be established and Riosks act up for access to Digital consultation. Importance of digitalization of all scams especially when government was providing bandwidth for Digital Health. Dr. Sujini Ponnusamy elaborated on a diagnostic report being uploaded on a cloud for its assessment and inference. This would require an infrastructure and her organisation was working towards it. She also spoke briefly on Telemedicine and remote patient monitoring through Centralized Repository (Kiosks).

	Areas of concern in this digitalization with aspects of Data breach, Data ownership, standardization issues, and normalization issues were impressed upon and this had to be ironed out for a smooth transformation towards Digital health. Hospitals and other healthcare setups will largely benefit with adoption of Digital health. All of this comes with financial implications and the seminar left salient features as 'food for thought' for the audience. Last but not the least, funds allotment and utilization by M.HFW will be the last straw for propelling our country towards Digital Health Transformation.
