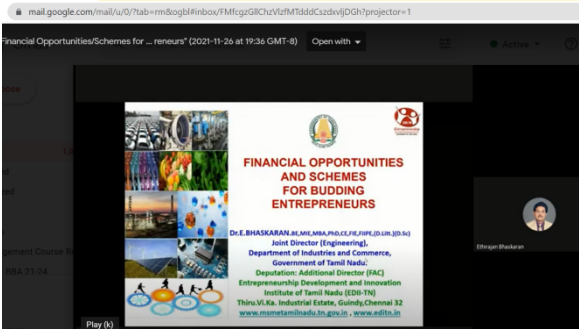

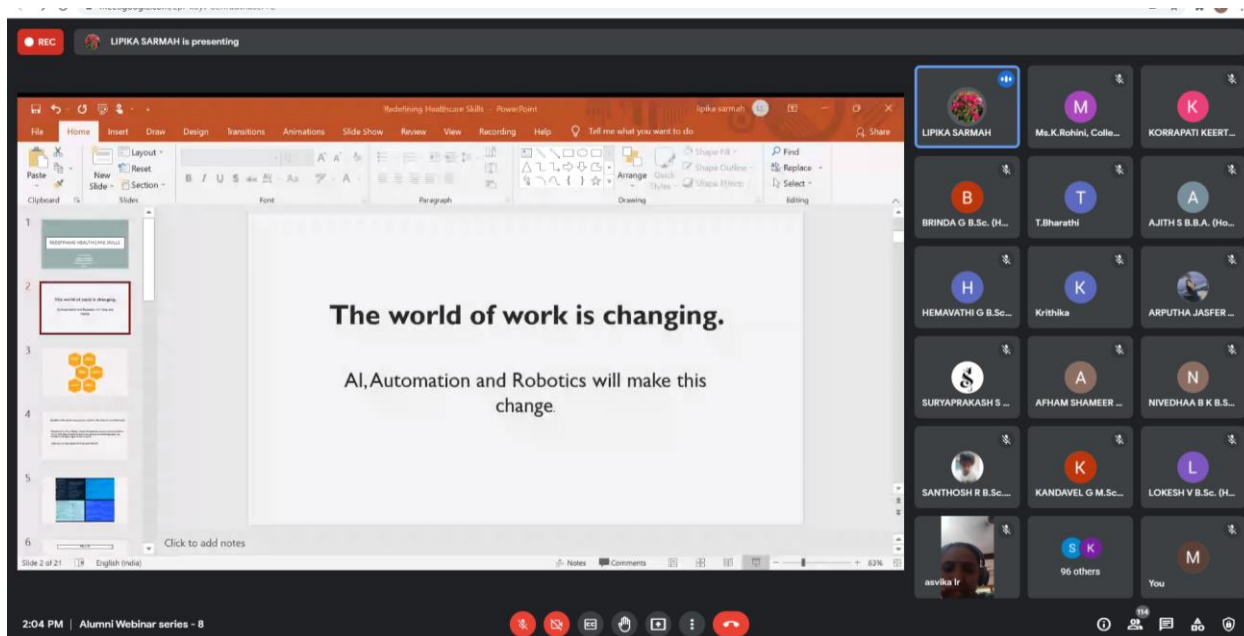

RESULTS

- The result showed respondents proficiency was lowest in two skills groups in the digital category- software and development and understanding digital systems.
- Proficiency in the skills groups for communication and planning and ways of working was also lower than average
- Participants with an University degree has high average proficiency scores across 56 distinct elements of talent, suggesting that those with higher levels of education are better prepared for changes in the workplace.

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GAP ???

- There's a soft skills gap in healthcare candidates due to several factors, including shifts in focus in the education system, technology, and stress.
- Healthcare workers are expected to deal with stressful situations every day. Maintaining a level of professionalism—defined as "having a courteous, conscientious, and respectful approach to all interactions and situations in the workplace"—is essential for navigating these stressful situations.
- Over 1.5 million new employees arrive on the job prepared and competent with the required hard skills. However, within the first year and a half of employment, 46% underperform based on issues related to work ethic and attitude.

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THERE ARE SEVERAL WAYS TO HELP CLOSE THE GAP.

- Personality assessment tests**
The first step is to understand yourself better to see where improvement might be needed. Personality tests can help people identify their strengths, weaknesses, and tendencies in their natural personality. Becoming self-aware is the first step in personal growth.
- In-person training, mentoring, and coaching**
People who discover there is room to improve soft skills can consider seeking help from a mentor or asking a manager for coaching.
- Online training**
Some essential soft skills like time management and prioritization can be learned through online programs.
- Role-playing**
Role-playing offers the opportunity to practice essential skills. Practice different scenarios that challenge communication and teamwork skills. Pay attention to timing, inflection, tone, and body language.
