Date: 14/02/22

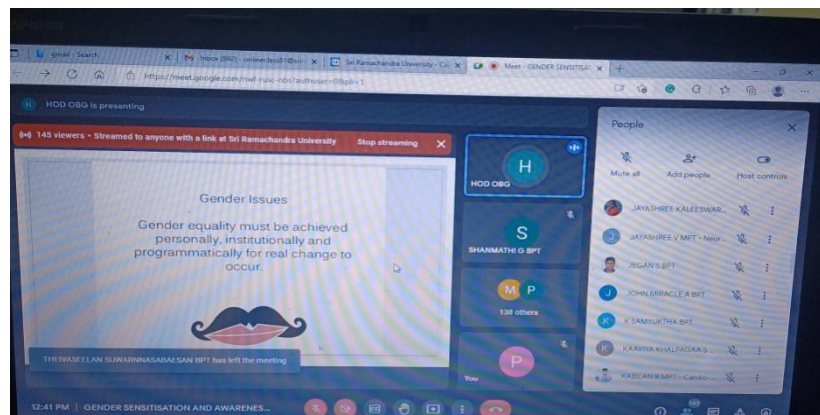
Time: 12-1pm
