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ENGLISH LANGUAGE TRAINING– 2021

The ability enhancement course - **English (AAE -001)** which is a foundation course that helps students to adapt to the transitions from school to college allowing to bridge the gap among these heterogeneous groups was introduced as compulsory paper to 11 paramedic programmes at entry level of semester -1. The course had 587 takers with 76 students from B. Sc BMS, 28 students from B. SC TCM, 27 students from B. SC Sports Med, 175 students from B. SC AHS & MRIT, 33 students from BBA, 43 students from B. SC Cl. Nutrition, 102 students from BPT, 31 from B.Sc Med. Micro Biology, 11 from B.Sc (Hons) EHS, 47 from B. Sc Applied Psychology and 9 from B. Sc Clinical Research.

The ability enhancement course titled- **English for Clinical Communication (AAE -002)** was offered to 5 different UG programmes with clinical nature such as Trauma care and Optometry in the second semester. The course aims to enable students to understand the role of English in clinical set up and build appropriate skills to effectively perform as interlocutors. The course has had 175 takers with 40 students from B. OPTOM, 33 students from BBA, 28 students from B. SC TCM, 43 students from B. SC Cl. Nutrition with an additional 31 from B.Sc Med Micro Biology who have learnt it in the semester 1.

Apart from these programmes of CBCS, four other **UG Non CBCS programmes** of Nursing (nos.2), Pharmacy Hospital Ward Technician Course have English course that follow the syllabus recommended by the respective councils. The B.Sc Nursing had 100 takers, P C BSC Nursing had 13 takers, B PHARM had 110 and HWTC had 35 takers with a total of 258

A skills enhancement course of CBCS titled '**Functional Language Skills**' (**ASE – 009**) was offered at PG level. The courses concentrate on developing language

aptitude to support research writing. The course had 4 from Applied Child Development in sem 2.

The English language Unit also offered a course on Soft skills enhancement named - '**Communication and Soft skills**' AAE -003 at semester three of UG programmes. The course has had 40 takers from BBA, 64 from B.SC Applied Psychology , 40 from B.Optom and 29 from B.Sc Micro Biology with a total of 173 participants.

A paper titled , 'Communication Skills' had 9 students form BSc Public Health.

Business Communication refreshers Course had 54 participants from MBA.

A total of 1,260 students underwent English language training in 2021.
